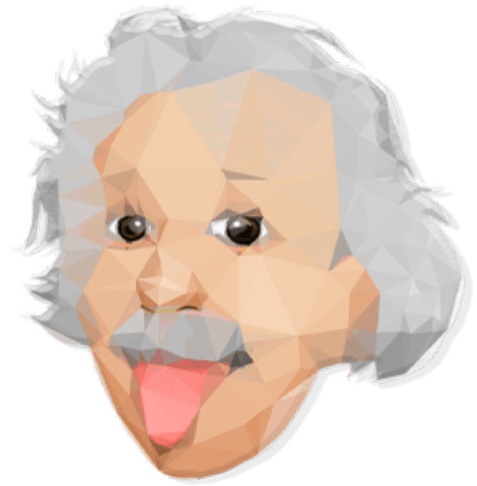


YOU ARE A
